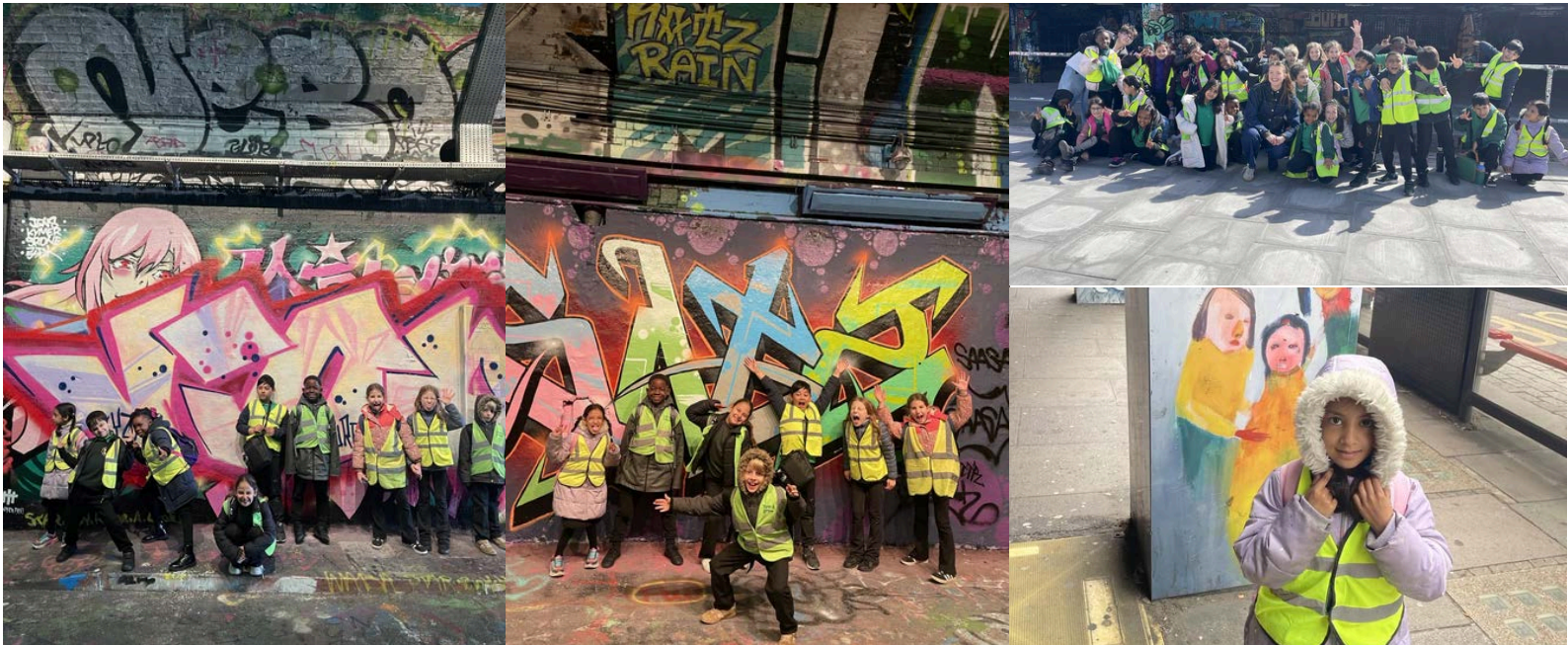
- Chicken Mango Salad with Bread

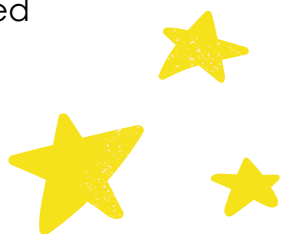
